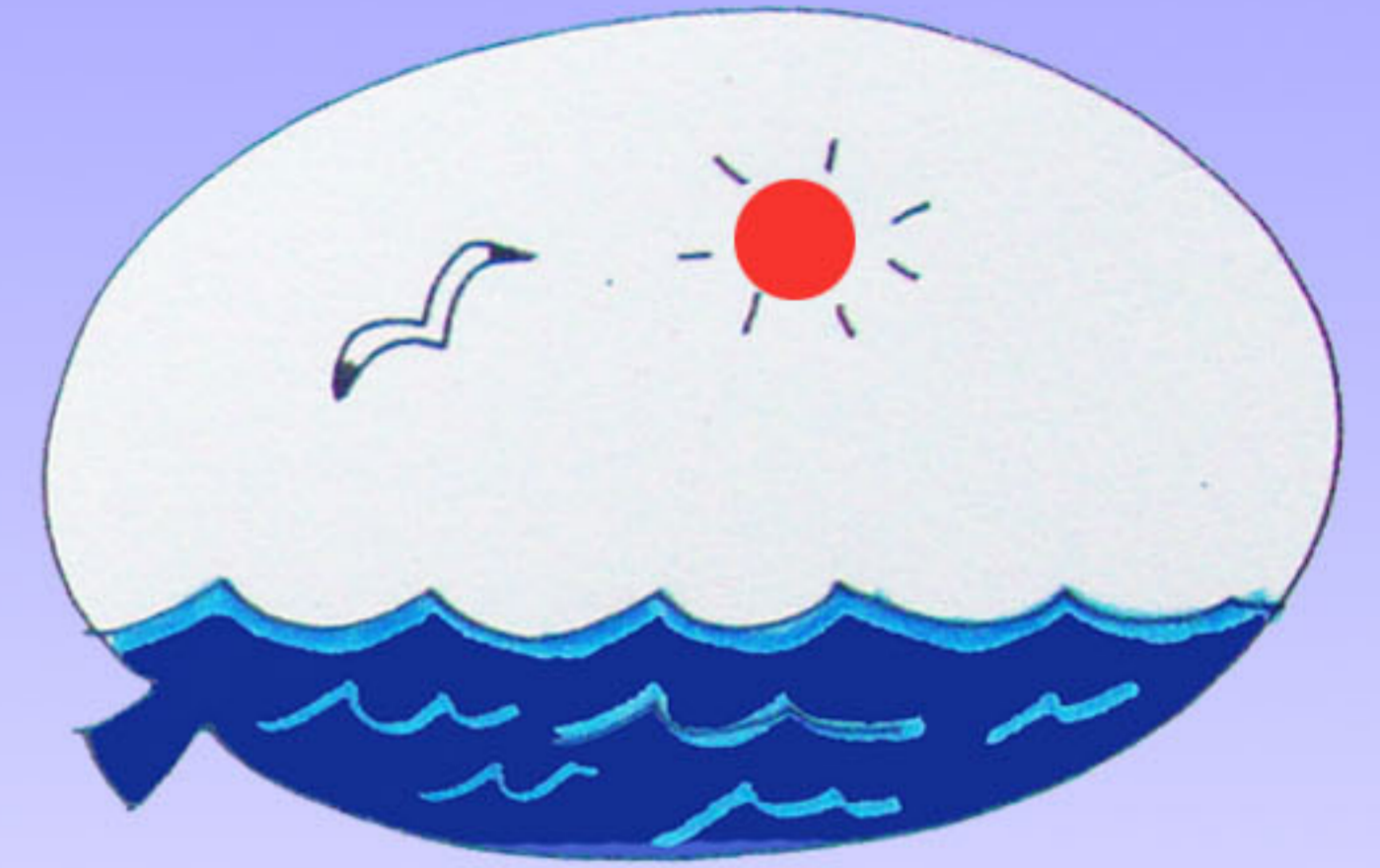


# The Long Trip

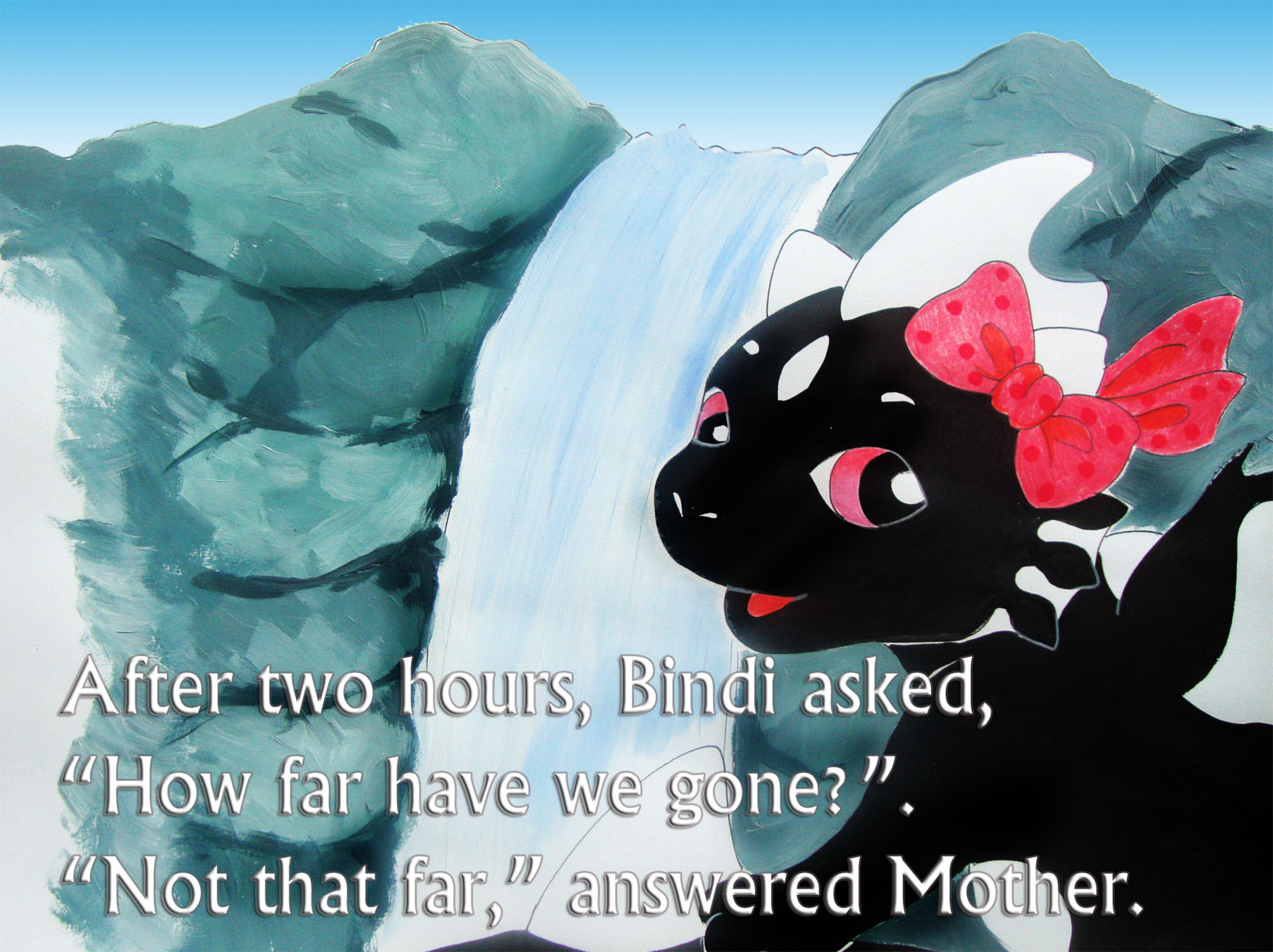

“Nine hours,” replied Mother.

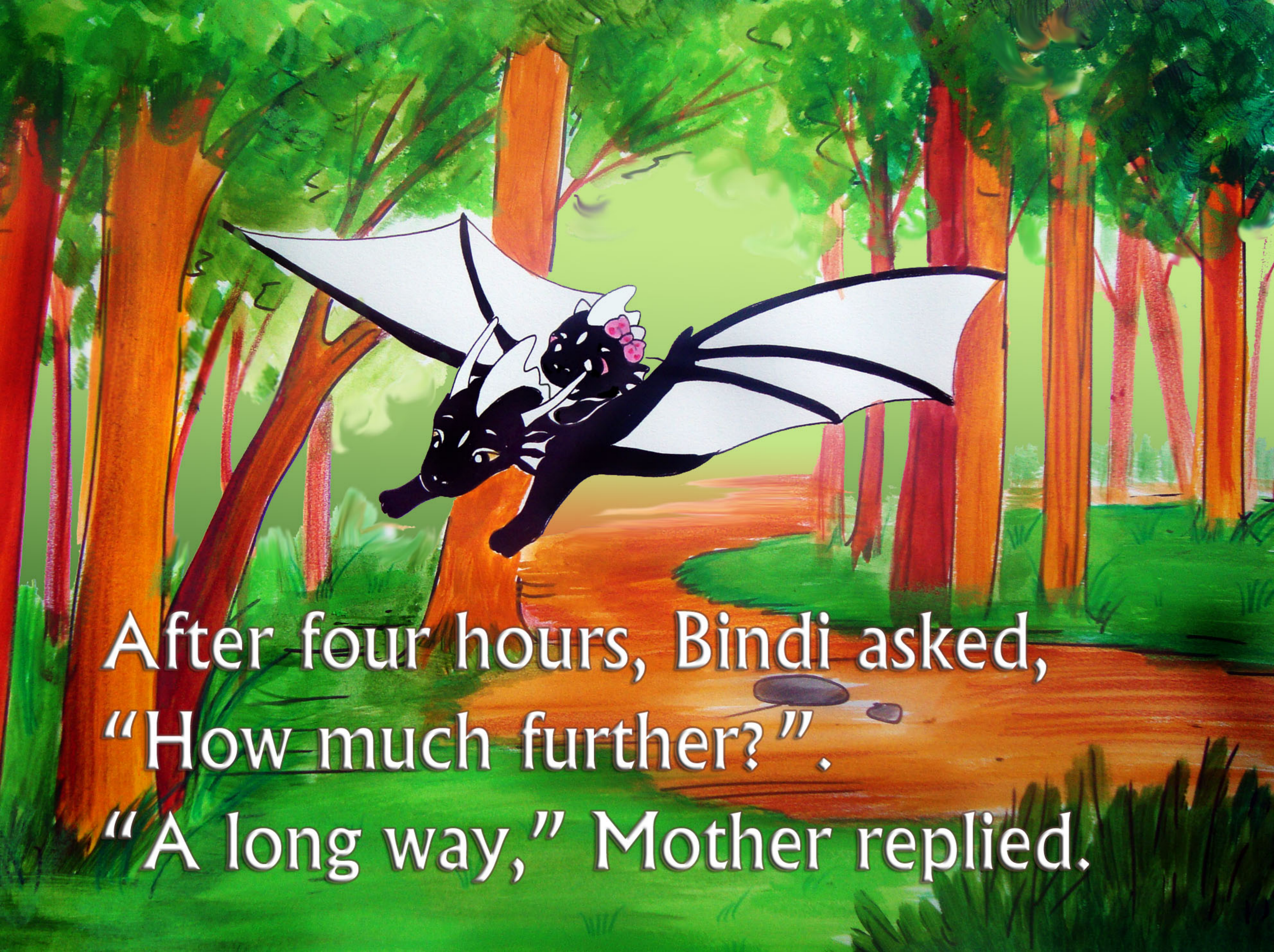


After two hours, Bindi asked,

“It’s 4pm,” said Mother.



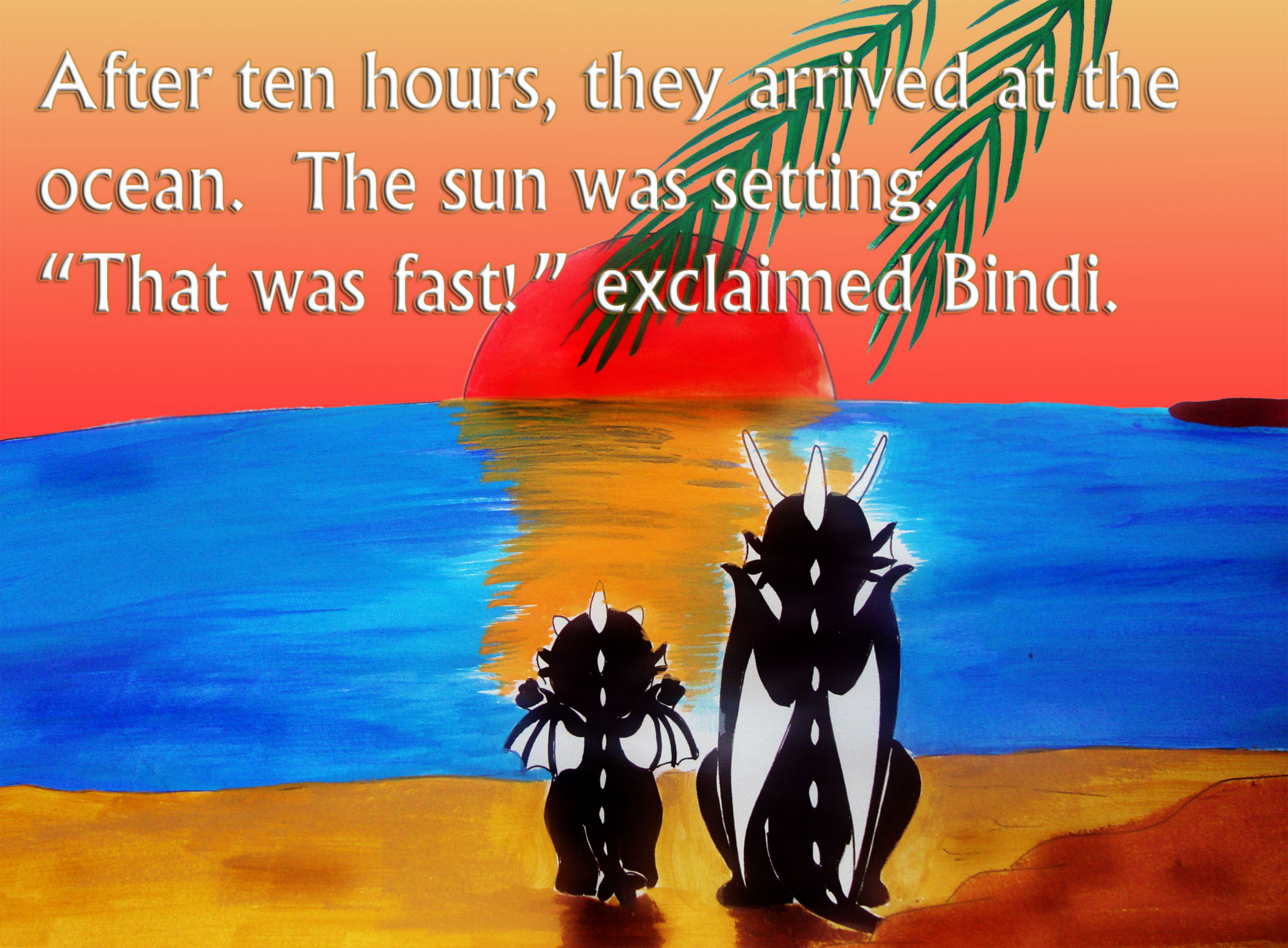
After eight hours, Bindi took a nap.
